## GUIDANCE NOTES FOR PLAYER REGISTATION FORM IN ACCORDANCE WITH RFU REGULATION 14

SECTION 3	<b>17 year olds playing adult rugby</b> Players may only play adult rugby, or train with other adults, when they have reached their eighteenth birthday unless they are aged 17 and have been assessed as capable of playing with adults and the RFU's playing adult rugby form has been duly completed and signed in accordance with RFU Regulation 15.1. It will not be possible to register a 17 year old to play adult rugby unless the form has been duly completed and signed, confirmation of this undertaking is in Section [3] of the Player Registration Form.
SECTION 4	Where the player's country of birth is not the UK and he is registering for a club at Level 1-4 (inc) or he is a contracted non-UK born player at any level, a photocopy of the passport (identity page with photograph) and valid visa, must be submitted.
SECTION 4 (EQP)	<b>For Premiership &amp; Championship clubs only</b> Section 4 of the registration form relates to the RFU's England Qualified Player scheme and must be completed if the player meets the requirements for England eligibility.
